He pursued his Ph.D and Post-doc fellowship in Physics from University of Western Ontario, Canada during 1990-1994. Dr. Singh has been an educational administrator for more than 23 years. He has elaborate experience in institution building and has worked as founder Vice Chancellor of Sharda University, Dean of Punjab Technical University, Director of IGNOU and Deputy Director at AICTE (all nationally renowned academic organizations). Dr. Singh has made exceptional contribution in Blended learning systems, teaching learning pedagogical innovations and extensive use of technology in institutional governance. Presently, Dr. Singh is spearheading many quality improvements schemes of the Government which includes analysis of Grievances, Zero Defect Zero Effect (ZED) model for MSMEs, Swachh Sarvekshan, Certification of Yoga Professionals etc. at QCI.
